

## Green House Gas Emissions Reporting - Overview

Washington Department of Ecology's Air Quality Program is holding workshops for owners or operators of stationary and mobile sources of greenhouse gas emissions that meet the reporting thresholds adopted by the Legislature in 2008. Owners or operators of emissions sources meeting the reporting threshold will need to report their calendar year emissions. Reporting begins for certain sources beginning with the reporting of 2009 emissions in 2010. The workshops are an opportunity to learn more about whether or not you will have to report, when reporting requirements will begin, what will need to be reported, and how to report.
