Woodstove Change-out Rebate Application Form

Yakima County residents can make a clean air choice and save money! Yakima Regional Clean Air Agency (YRCAA) is offering Rebates when you replace your non-certified wood stove or insert with a new wood, pellet, natural gas, propane or electric device.

Please note: Complete all sections of this application and retain a copy for your records. The Rebate Program is not responsible for materials lost by mail. Applications may be hand-delivered to our address. (See above.) Applications also available to the customer by downloading an application form from our website: www.yakimacleanair.org. Please use blue ink to fill out the application. You may mail in or drop the application by our office. Remember to include your “Ugly Stove” picture with your application.

Applications are processed in the order received. Rebate vouchers will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis to qualified homeowners or rental property owners who use wood heat as a source and live within Yakima County, but not within the borders of the Yakima Indian Reservation. The Wood-burning device must be in a primary residence, and household must burn 3 or more cords of wood a year to qualify. The homeowner enjoys the freedom to visit all of our participating partners, and take advantage of any sale price. Once the stove is professionally installed, and all purchase installation paperwork has been received by YRCAA, your Rebate Check will be mailed within 6-8 weeks.

Funding is limited, and not guaranteed unless a voucher has been issued. Vouchers will be reimbursed as a post-installation rebate, and will only apply to devices purchased through a participating retailer. Review additional program terms in the page, “How the Rebate Program Works” prior to signing below.

Please Note: *New heating devices must be purchased through participating partners.* Purchase and installation costs vary, but typically start around \$2,500. Ask your vendor about the IRS tax credit available to homeowners who make green improvements to their home.

- ❖ **\$100.00 Rebate** to first-time propane users, in addition to the rebate above.
- ❖ **\$75.00 Propane Discount** for new tank set-up, or first fill of existing propane tank.
