 PERMIT CONDITIONS Do not burn inside the urban growth areas of Selah, Yakima, Union Gap, Toppenish, Grandview, Sunnyside, Tieton, Naches, Moxee, Granger, Zillah, or Mabton. Do not burn or add fuel during any stage of an air pollution episode or local air quality burn ban. For each day of burning, prior to burning, call 834-2050 and speak to the outdoor burning Program Manager to determine the quantity of material allowed to be burned for that day. Burn only during daylight hours (do not start burning later than two hours before sunset). Burn when the wind takes smoke away from roads, homes, population centers, or other public areas, to the greatest extent possible. 				

- **6.** Allow woody material to dry no less than 90 days if removed from the ground between October 15th and March 15th and 30 days if removed from the ground between March 15th and October 15th.
- 7. Arrange piles to promote efficient burning as the material in the center is burned.
- 8. When accelerating a fire use only propane or other gaseous fuel (do not use diesel or other liquid fuel).
- 9. Maintain piles to allow maximum turbulence from air movement to ensure as hot a fire as possible.
- 10. Attend the fire at all times (with the capability to extinguish) and manage the fire to minimize the smoke.
- 11. Burn only natural vegetation. Do not burn garbage, animals, asphalt, petroleum products, paints, rubber products,
- plastics, paper (other than what is necessary to start a fire), cardboard, treated wood, construction debris, or metal.
- 12. Comply with all fire safety regulations. Do not burn during adverse weather conditions (such as high winds or extremely dry conditions, and high temperatures or in close proximity to structures).
- 13. Burning on easements you must get permission from proper authorities before burning on easements.
- **14. Call fire dispatch** when your burn will emit a prominent column of smoke. (Upper County: 509-248-2103, Lower County: 509-865-4202)
- **15. Extinguish the fire** it creates a nuisance and/or a health or safety hazard.
- 16. Other Conditions:

Affidavit: I, the undersigned, have read, understand and accept the responsibility to comply with all the conditions. Failure to comply with all conditions specified above is a violation, subject to penalty. I agree that YRCAA may enter my property for inspection of compliance with permit conditions.
