1. Call to Order

Chairperson DeVaney called the meeting to order at 2:01 p.m. in the council chambers, Yakima City Hall; 129 N Second St.; Yakima, Washington.

2. Roll Call

Thornsbury conducted roll call and declared a quorum present.

3. Changes to the Agenda

DeVaney asked if there were any changes to the agenda. None were requested.

4. Public Comment

DeVaney asked if there were any public comments. None were offered.

5. Board Officer Election

DeVaney asked for nominations for board chairperson and vice chairperson. Jones nominated DeVaney as chairperson and Hilda González as vice chairperson. DeVaney asked if there were any other nominations. McKinney expressed support for the slate nominated and moved to elect Jon DeVaney as board chairperson and Hilda González as board vice chairperson. Jones seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

6. Board Meeting Minutes for December 11, 2025

DeVaney asked if there were any corrections to the minutes. McKinney moved to approve the December 11, 2025, minutes. Jones seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

He added staff was working on annual registration.

McKinney moved to adjourn. Jones seconded. Motion passed 2-0. DeVaney adjourned the meeting at 2:23 p.m.
