

New Source Review (NSR)

New air pollution sources and modifications to existing sources which result in emissions increase, and new or altered air pollution control equipment are required to submit a NSR application and receive an order of approval prior to the construction, installation, establishment, or modification.

Some of the facilities, equipment and processes that require NSR and approval include, but are not limited to the following:

- boilers
- use of solvents
- backup generators
- dry cleaning
- surface coating
- metal fabricating

- confined cattle feeding operations
- gasoline storage and dispensing
- printing and graphic arts operations
- wastewater treatment plants
- industrial / commercial processes and equipment
- dairy operations

The NSR Application Form must be completed and submitted along with any detailed schematics, associated environmental information, modeling results, and other pertinent information.

Once the application is submitted and the application fee is paid an initial review will be conducted and the engineer will notify the applicant that, either more information is needed, or that the application is complete. When work is complete and an Order of Approval is issued, the applicant will be issued and invoice for the actual time spent preparing the order.
