YAKIMA REGIONAL CLEAN AIR AGANCY DRAFT NEW SOURCE REVIEW ORDER OF APPROVAL (Order/Permit)

Permit Applicant:

Buren Sheet Metal 3801 W. Washington Ave. Yakima, WA. 98903

Yakima Regional Clean Air Agency (YRCAA) is seeking comments on a draft Order of Approval (Order/Permit) for a New Source Review (NSR) for Buren Sheet Metal located at 3801 W. Washington Ave., Yakima, WA. The Order is for the installation of a sandblasting booth controlled by a dust collector with airflow capacity of 7,200 Cubic Feet per Minute. Buren Sheet Metal is the owner and operator of a metal fabrication plant. Air emissions are in the form of small particulates (PM_{10} and $PM_{2.5}$) and Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) some of which are known to be Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) or Toxic Air Pollutants (TAPs), pursuant to the Federal Clean Air Act (FCAA) and the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-460-150 respectively. Air emissions from the operation are within the air emission standards pursuant to air regulations. The draft Order compiles the air quality requirements into one document and establishes monitoring and recordkeeping to ensure compliance with those requirements. The draft Permit may affect the type or quantity of air emissions from the facility, and does not authorize any increase in emissions above those already allowed by the regulation.

Written comments relating to the issuance of this permit must be received by the office on or before the close of business day of October 28, 2017.

A public hearing may be held if the Agency determines that there is significant public interest. Request for a public hearing must be submitted within the comment period. Any such request for a public hearing must indicate the interest of the person or organization filing it, and describe why a hearing is necessary.
