YAKIMA REGIONAL CLEAN AIR AGANCY DRAFT NEW SOURCE REVIEW ORDER OF APPROVAL (Order/Permit)

Farwest Operators dba Farwest Fabricators, Inc. 7537 Postma Rd. Moxee, WA 98936

Yakima Regional Clean Air Agency (YRCAA) is seeking comments on a draft Order of Approval (Order/Permit) for a New Source Review (NSR) at the above location for Farwest Fabricators. The Permit is for a Rohner BOHT-SLWP-10-10-12-DE Industrial Batch Oven rated at 1.0 Million Btu/Hr. – High Temperature for Powder Coating Process. Farwest Fabricators is the owner and operator of a metal fabrication facility. Air emissions from this operation are in form of small Particulate Matters (PM_{10} and $PM_{2.5}$) and Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) some of which are known to be Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) and or Toxic Air Pollutants (TAPs) in accordance with the FCAA and the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-460-150, respectively. Air emissions from this operation are within the air emission standards pursuant to air regulations. The draft Order compiles the air quality requirements into one document and establishes monitoring and recordkeeping to ensure compliance with those requirements. The draft Permit may affect the type or quantity of air emissions from the facility, and does not authorize any increase in emissions above those already allowed by the regulation.

Written comments relating to the issuance of this permit must be received by the office on or before the close of business day of May 25, 2018.

A public hearing may be held if the Agency determines that there is significant public interest. Request for a public hearing must be submitted within the comment period. Any such request for a public hearing must indicate the interest of the person or organization filing it, and describe why a hearing is necessary.
