Yakima Regional Clean Air Agency (YRCAA) is seeking comments on a draft New Source Review (NSR) Order of Approval (Order/Permit) for a heated downdraft spray paint booth, (14'Wx30'Lx9'H) with 15,000 actual cubic feet per minute (ACFM) of air flow and an AFC perp station at the above location. In addition, the facility submitted a State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) checklist for the proposed project. Go Collision LLC is the owner and operator of an automobile body shop. The facility is proposing to move to the above location from its current location at 2nd St. Yakima. Air emissions from this Facility are in form of small Particulate Matters (PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5}) and Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) some of which are known to be Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) or Toxic Air Pollutants (TAPs) in accordance with the Federal Clean Air Act (FCAA) and the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-460-150, respectively. Air emissions are within air emission standards pursuant to air regulations. The draft Order compiles the air quality requirements into one document and establishes monitoring and recordkeeping to ensure compliance with those requirements. The draft Permit may affect the type or quantity of air emissions from the facility, and does not authorize any increase in emissions above those already allowed by the regulation.
