

## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

DRAFT NEW SOURCE REVIEW ORDER OF APPROVAL (Order/Permit)

**Permit Applicant:** Sick Custom Body & Paint

**Address/Location:** 100 N<sup>th</sup> 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Sunnyside, WA. 98944

Yakima Regional Clean Air Agency (YRCAA) is seeking comments on a draft Order of Approval (Order/Permit) for a New Source Review (NSR) for a spray booth, Col-Met, Model number ECC-14-09-26-N-SB-S (14'Wx26'Lx9'H) with 12,600 Actual Cubic Feet per Minute (ACFM) of Air Flow at the above location. Sick Custom Body & Paint is the owner and operator of an automobile body shop with a spray booth. Air emissions from this Facility are in form of small Particulate Matters (PM<sub>10</sub> and PM<sub>2.5</sub>) and Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs) some of which are known to be Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs) or Toxic Air Pollutants (TAPs) in accordance with the Federal Clean Air Act (FCAA) and the Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 173-460-150, respectively. Air emissions are within air emission standards pursuant to air regulations. The draft Order compiles the air quality requirements into one document and establishes monitoring and recordkeeping to ensure compliance with those requirements. The draft Permit may affect the type or quantity of air emissions from the facility, and does not authorize any increase in emissions above those already allowed by the regulation.

Written comments relating to the issuance of this permit must be received by close of business day of July 21, 2017 and must be submitted to the attention of Engineering, Compliance and Planning Division., Yakima Regional Clean Air Agency.

A public hearing may be held if the Agency determines that there is significant public interest. Request for a public hearing must be submitted within the comment period. Any such request for a public hearing must indicate the interest of the person or organization filing it, and describe why a hearing is necessary.
